Visit the terroir and vineyards of Versailles, Classified A.O.C. Île-de-France, which was part of the largest wine-producing region in France. A team of passionate winegrowers, who have worked with the great wines of Bordeaux, Corsica and Napa Valley, wanted to bring this historic site back to life by producing wines of great quality and character, produced biodynamically. The vineyard is planted in a balanced and biodiverse manner, on a 26-hectare plot of land in a single block, located on a high plateau.

The name "Domaine de La Bouche du Roi" is a reference to the Sun King.

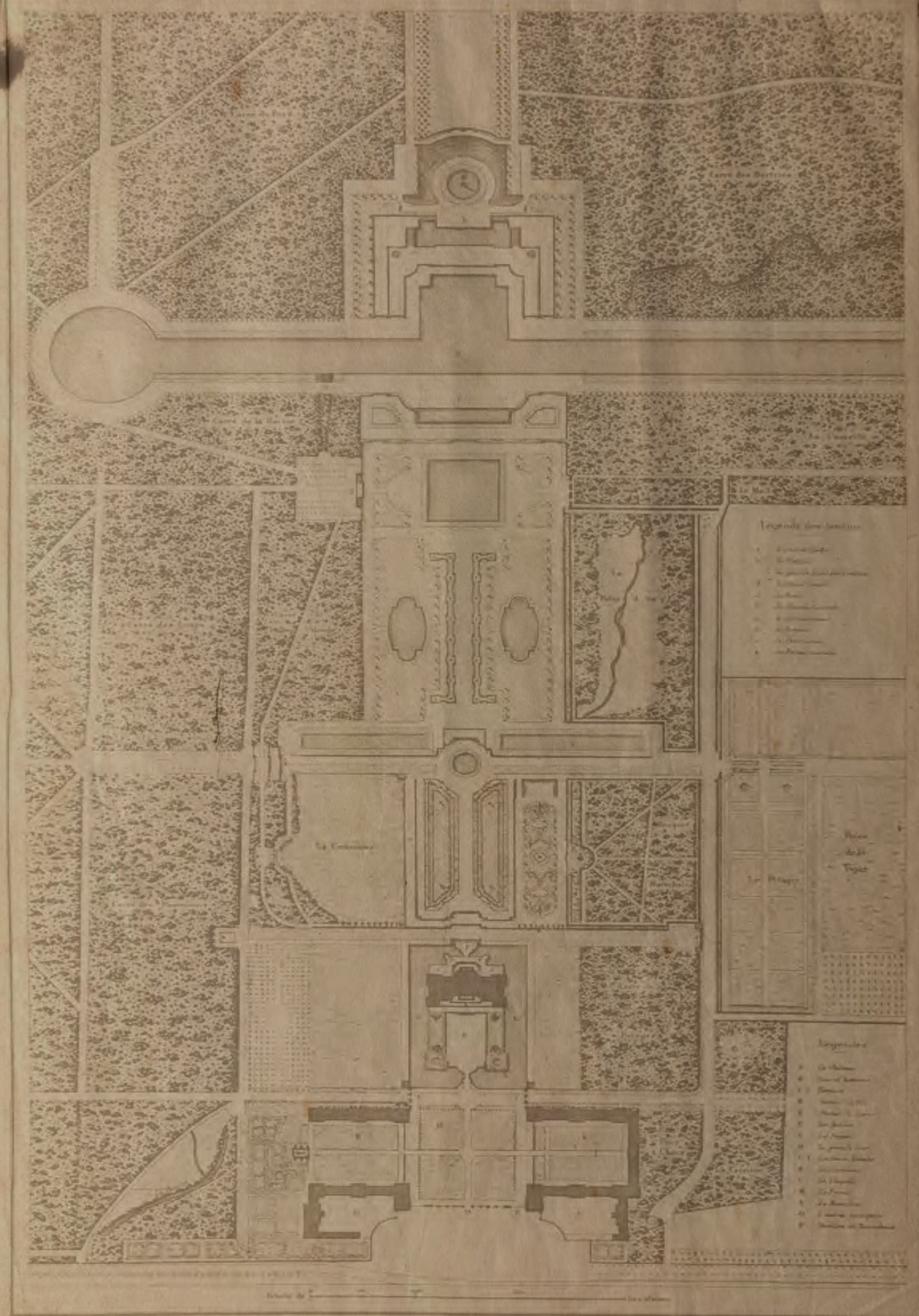

Visit the magnificent Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte, the brainchild of three artists brought together by Nicolas Fouquet, the King's Superintendent of Finances: the gardener André Le Nôtre, the architect Louis Le Vau and the painter and decorator Charles Le Brun. The result of the fraternal genius of these three men, the Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte is a model of majesty and balance.

Dazzled by their work, King Louis XIV called on them to build Versailles.

Vaux-le-Vicomte would inspire not only Versailles, but the whole of Europe for centuries to come.

A cocktail reception will be served in the lounges and garden of the hotel. Mr Bruno Paillard, accompanied by Alexia Martin Buysse, they will help us discover and taste different champagnes (Maison Bruno Paillard).

Versailles, an absolute masterpiece of French art, designed by King Louis XIV, Versailles was the residence of the King, the Court and the Royal Government until October 1789. Many European sovereigns drew inspiration from Versailles for the construction of their châteaux.

For its construction, The Sun King called on the craftsmen and artists who had worked at Vaux-le-Vicomte.

The Breteuil family began to make their mark under the reign of King Louis XIV. Louis de Breteuil enjoyed rapid success, rising from Counselor to the Parliament of Brittany to Controller General of Finance, with the rank of Minister.

It was he who introduced Colbert to the nation's accounts.

The author of "The Tales of Mother Goose", Charles Perrault, was one of his close collaborators.

In 1661, Louis XIV commissioned André Le Nôtre to create and develop the gardens of Versailles, which he considered to be as important as the Château. Work began at the same time as the Château and lasted for around forty years. The King himself had all the projects submitted to him and wanted "the details of everything". Jules Hardouin-Mansart, First Architect to the King and Superintendent of Buildings, built the Orangery and made the layout of the park simpler, in particular by modifying or opening up certain groves.

Creating the gardens required an enormous amount of work. Enormous "earthworks" were required to level the areas, lay out the flowerbeds, build the Orangery, and dig the ponds and the Canal, where there had previously been nothing but woods, meadows and marshes. Trees were transported from many provinces of France, and thousands of men, sometimes entire regiments, took part in this vast undertaking.

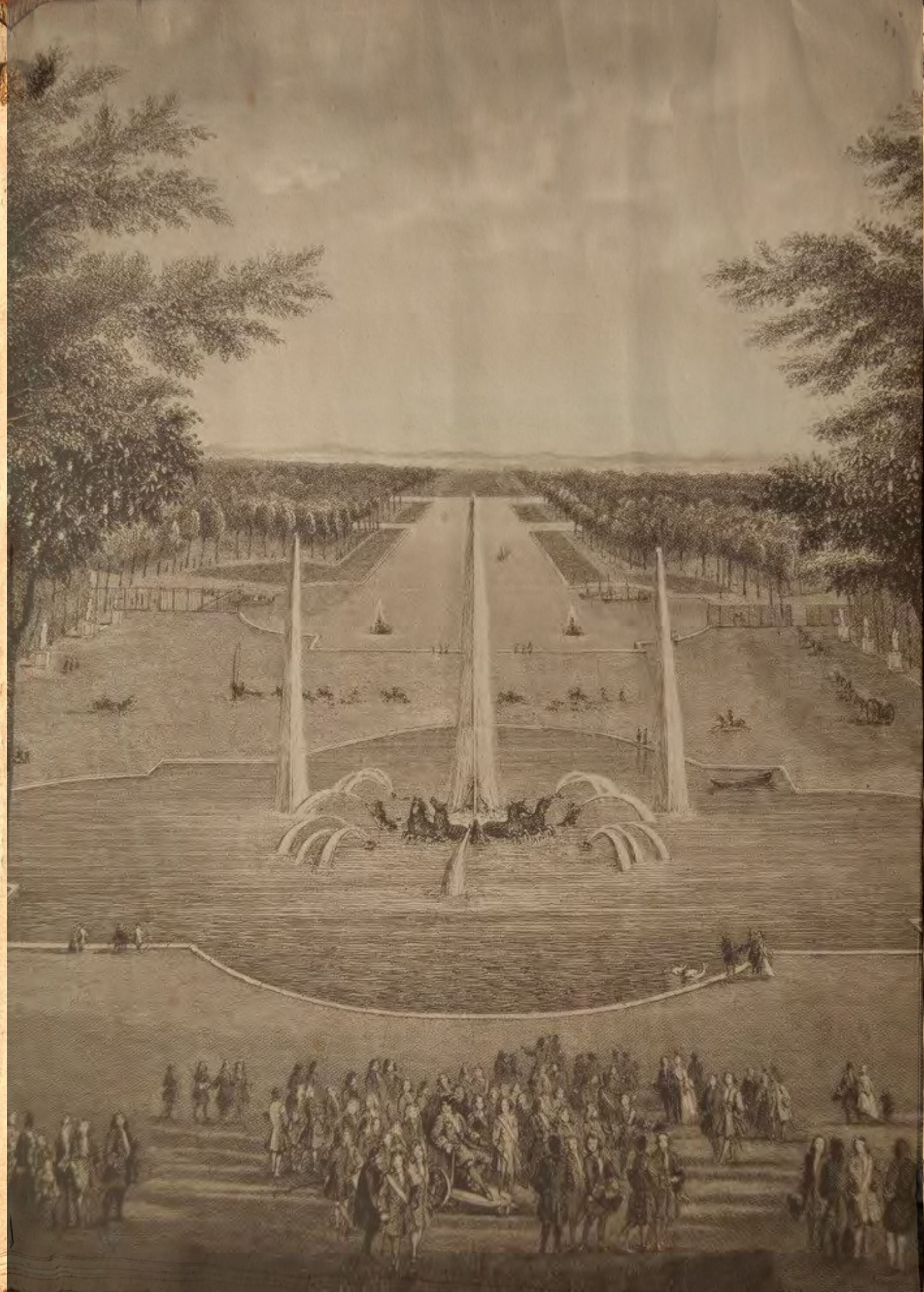

SVNDAY OCTOBER 13, 2024

The Grand Trianon was built at the request of King Louis XIV by the architect Jules-Hardouin Mansart near the Château de Versailles, at the end of the eastern arm of the Grand Canal.

The building's pink marble exterior gave it the name "Marble Trianon", as opposed to the porcelain Trianon that preceded it on the same site, built on the former village of Trianon.

Over the course of time and under different regimes, it has been the private residence of King Louis XIV as well as for numerous personalities such as Tsar Peter I of Russia and several French and foreign royal figures.

The King was particularly fond of Trianon, as Madame de Maintenon reported: *The King always has Trianon in mind.*
